Berks. Timber Merchant Deceased and Mary Trepass of Grace Church Street  
London Daughter of Nathaniel Trepass late of Welbeck in y<sup>e</sup> County  
of Oxford Carpenter Deceased and Francis his Wife single surviving  
Having Publicly declared their Intentions of taking each others in  
Marriage before several Meetings of the People of God called Quakers in  
London according to y<sup>e</sup> good order used among them whose proceedings therein  
after due Enquiry and Deliberate Consideration thereof (with Regard unto  
the Righteous Law of God) were allowed by the said Meetings they appear-  
ing clear of all Objections and having also Consent of Parents and Relations  
Concerned. Now these are the Certificates inwhom it may concern that for the  
accomplishing of their said Marriage this Twelfth Day of the Month called  
November in the Year One thousand Seven hundred and twenty four, they  
the said John Sanfom & Mary Trepass appeared in a publick Assembly  
of the aforesaid People, & others met together for that End in their Meeting  
house near Devonshire Square in London, and in a solemn manner the  
said John Sanfom taking the said Mary Trepass by the hand did openly  
Declare as followeth, to wit In the year of the said year and in the presence of  
You whom I take to be my witnesses, I take this my Dear Friend Mary  
Trepass to be my Wife Promising thro' y<sup>e</sup> Lords Assistance to be unto her  
a true and loving Husband till it please the Lord by Death to separate us  
and then and there in the said Assembly the said Mary Trepass did in like  
manner declare as followeth, Friends in the fear of the Lord, and in y<sup>e</sup> presence  
of this Assembly whom I desire to be my witnesses, I take this my friend John  
Sanfom to be my Husband Promising thro' y<sup>e</sup> Lords Assistance to be unto him  
a loving & faithful Wife, till it please y<sup>e</sup> Lord by Death to separate us  
and y<sup>e</sup> said John Sanfom and Mary Trepass as a farther confirmation thereof  
did then & there to these presents set their hands  
We whose Names are hereunto subscribed being present among others at the  
Solemnizing of the above said Marriage & Subscription in manner aforesaid as  
Witnesses thereunto have also to these presents subscribed our Names the Day &  
Year above Written
